Accreditation Corner

The DoDEA Mission, Vision, and Core Values represent enduring principles that guide the efforts of Europe South and our school, Vicenza Elementary School. Among these core beliefs, Continuous Improvement is paramount, as it directs our focus toward meeting the diverse needs of all our students. In late February and early March 2023, Europe South schools will host an accreditation team comprising educators from both within and outside the DoDEA community.

Europe South schools, including Vicenza Elementary, welcome the opportunity to receive feedback and engage in collaborative efforts aimed at fulfilling our mission, vision, and core beliefs. Periodically, we will address frequently asked questions about the accreditation process.

What is accreditation?

Accreditation is a voluntary dual-purpose process that schools (1) must be worthy of the trust placed in them to provide high-quality learning opportunities and (2) clearly demonstrate continual self-improvement. An accredited school is focused on a mission and goals for students; it is student-oriented and examines its students' performance continuously; it accepts objective evaluation from a team of outside peer professionals; it maintains a qualified faculty within an effectively organized school; it collaboratively assesses the quality of its educational programs on a regular basis; and it plans for the future.

What does it mean to be accredited?

An accredited school has met an external set of rigorous set of standards and processes, which eases the process of transferring credits from one school to another as well as gaining greater access to federal loans, scholarships, postsecondary education and military programs that require attendance at an accredited institution.

Are all of DoDEA's schools accredited?

Yes, all of DoDEA's schools are accredited through Cognia.



CHAIN OF COMMAND

DoDEA, like the military, utilizes a chain of command.

Issues are best resolved at the lowest possible level. Parents must follow the chain of command, starting with the teacher or staff member. If an issue cannot be resolved directly with Vicenza Elementary School teachers/staff members, sponsors have access to the Assistant Principal and Principal. Going Home

Parents wishing to pick their children up from school may meet their children in the area in front of the school.

All students assigned to a bus will ride that bus *unless otherwise cleared with the transportation office*

Parents must meet their children at the home bus drop off point.
